- Successful passage of a Certified Physical Ability Test (CPAT)**
- EMT *preferred***

- Successful passage of City of Detroit Civil Servant Exam**
- Successful passage of City of Detroit Oral Examination**
- Successful passage of City of Detroit Physical Exam**

Once you have received your official acceptance letter from the City of Detroit Human Resources Department, you must do the following in order to join the ranks of the men and women of the Detroit Fire Department:

- Successful passage of Medical First Responder *(if applicable)***
- Successful passage of all academy training *(lecture & practicals)***
- Successful passage of the Fire Fighter I and Fire Fighter II state certification exam *(if applicable)***
