

## **ELECTRICAL/FIRE ALARM APPRENTICE CHECKLIST**

THE FOLLOWING IS A CHECKLIST OF REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR APPLICATION OF AN INITIAL OR RENEWAL APPRENTICE REGISTRATION.

EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 1, 2010, ALL ELECTRICAL APPRENTICES ARE REQUIRED TO BE PARTICIPATING IN AN ELECTRICAL TRAINING PROGRAM APPROVED BY THE ELECTRICAL ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD AS STIPULATED IN *PUBLIC ACT 407 OF 2016*. FAILURE TO DO SO INVALIDATES THE REGISTRATION. ANY HOURS ACCUMULATED ON AN INVALID REGISTRATION WILL NOT BE CREDITED TOWARDS THE JOURNEYMAN ELECTRICIAN EXAMINATION.

## **EXAMPLES OF ACCEPTABLE FORMS OF PROOF OF RESIDENCY ARE:**

## **Valid and Current:**

City of Detroit Municipal ID State of Michigan Driver's License State of Michigan ID

Utility bills in applicant's name reflecting, at minimum, the previous six months reflecting a City of Detroit address.

Passports and Water bills are not accepted
