Temple St & 14th St: can be important crossroad, with mixed use nodes



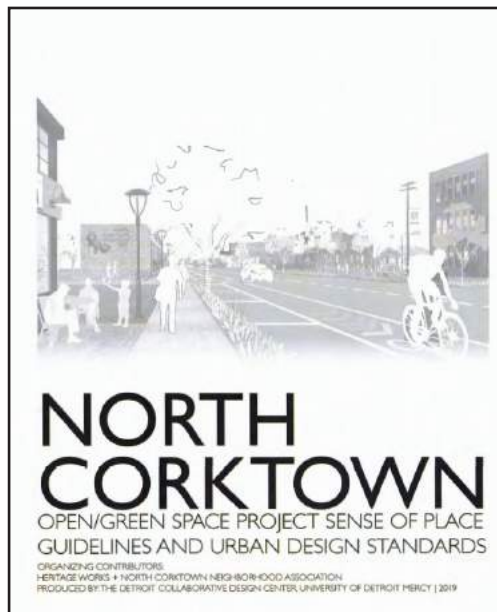
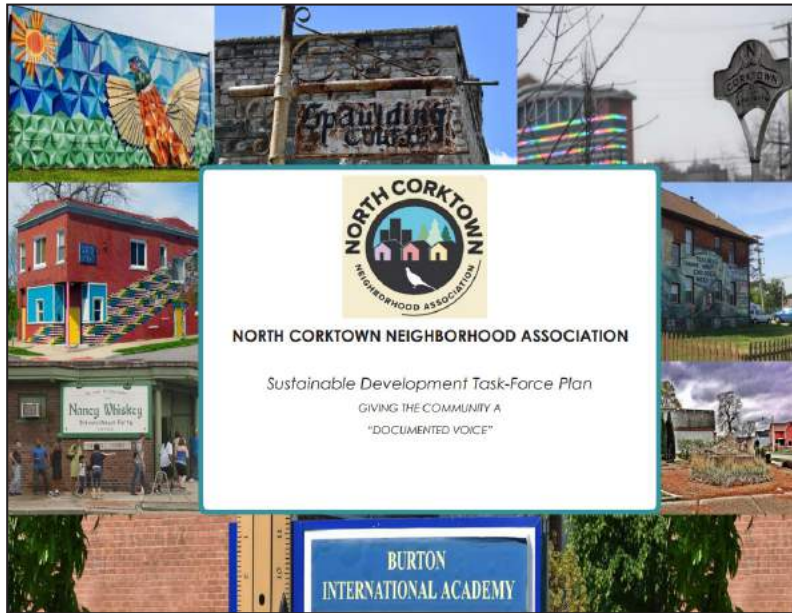
What we've heard

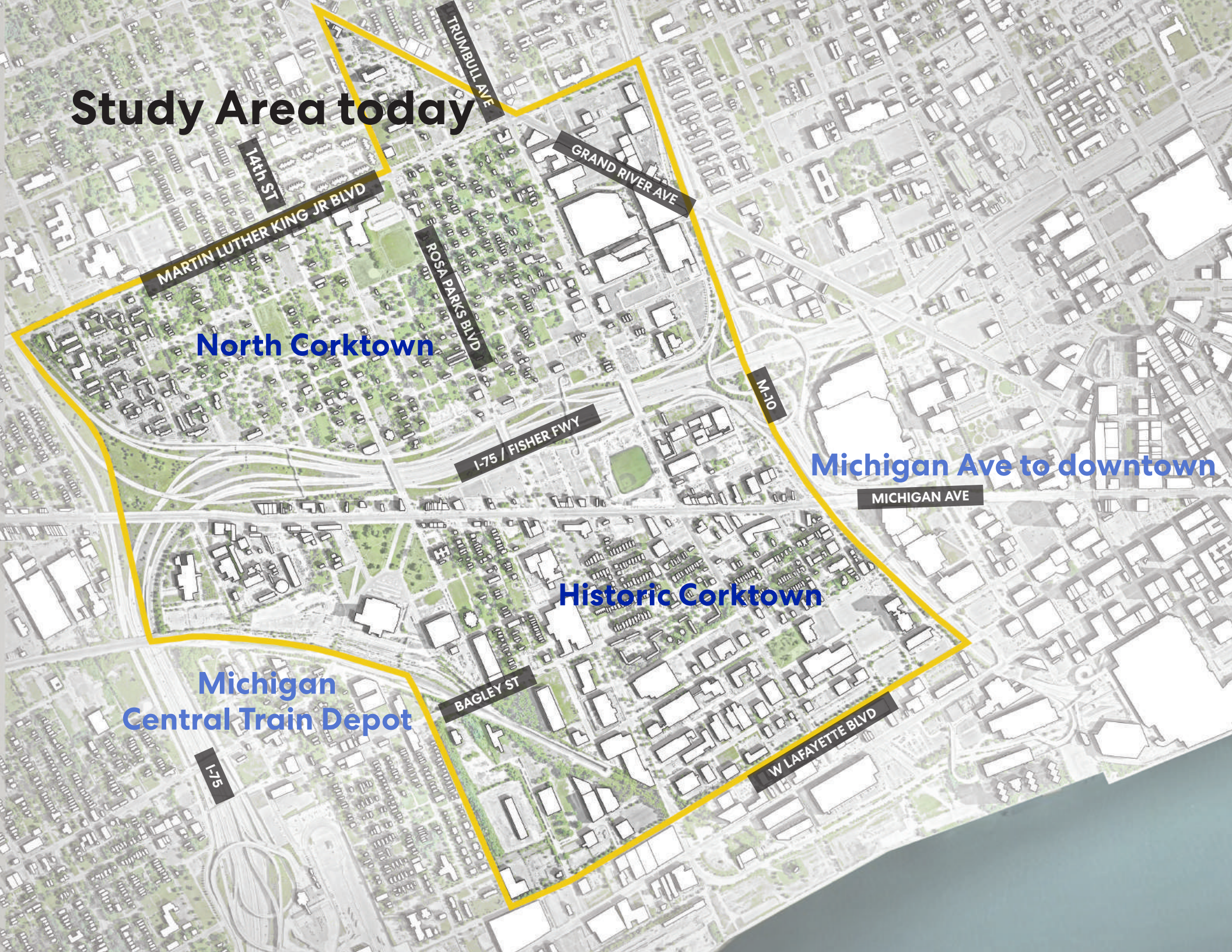

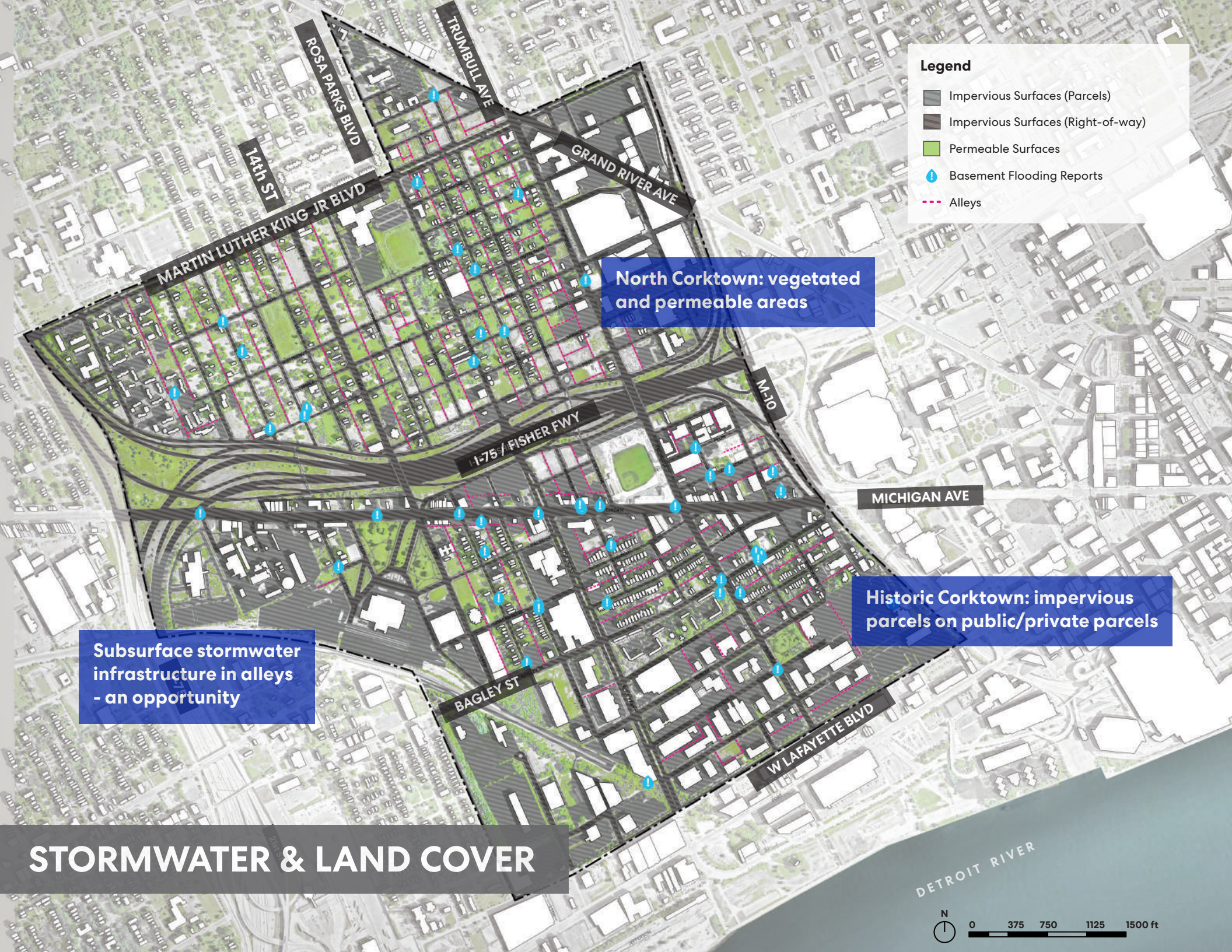

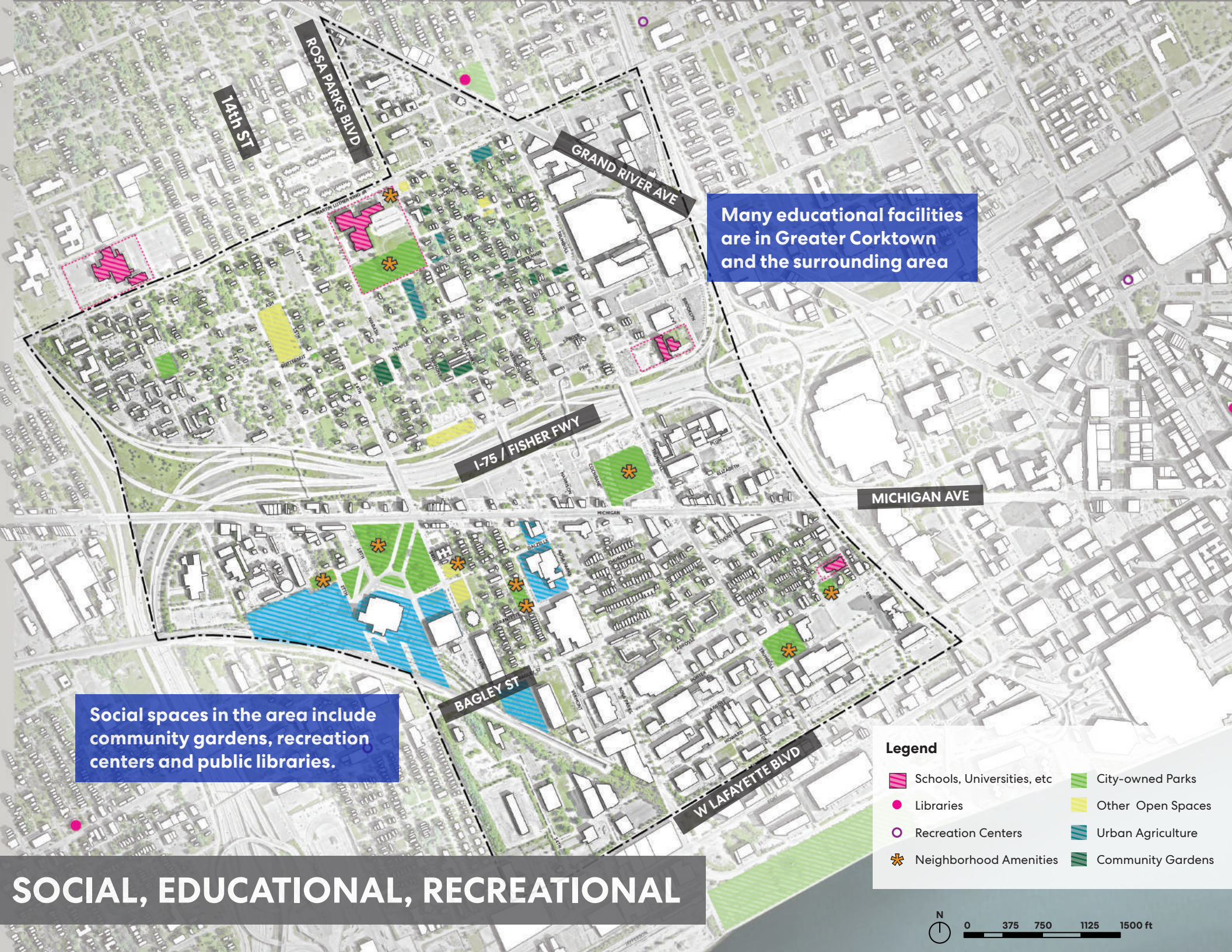

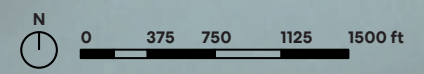

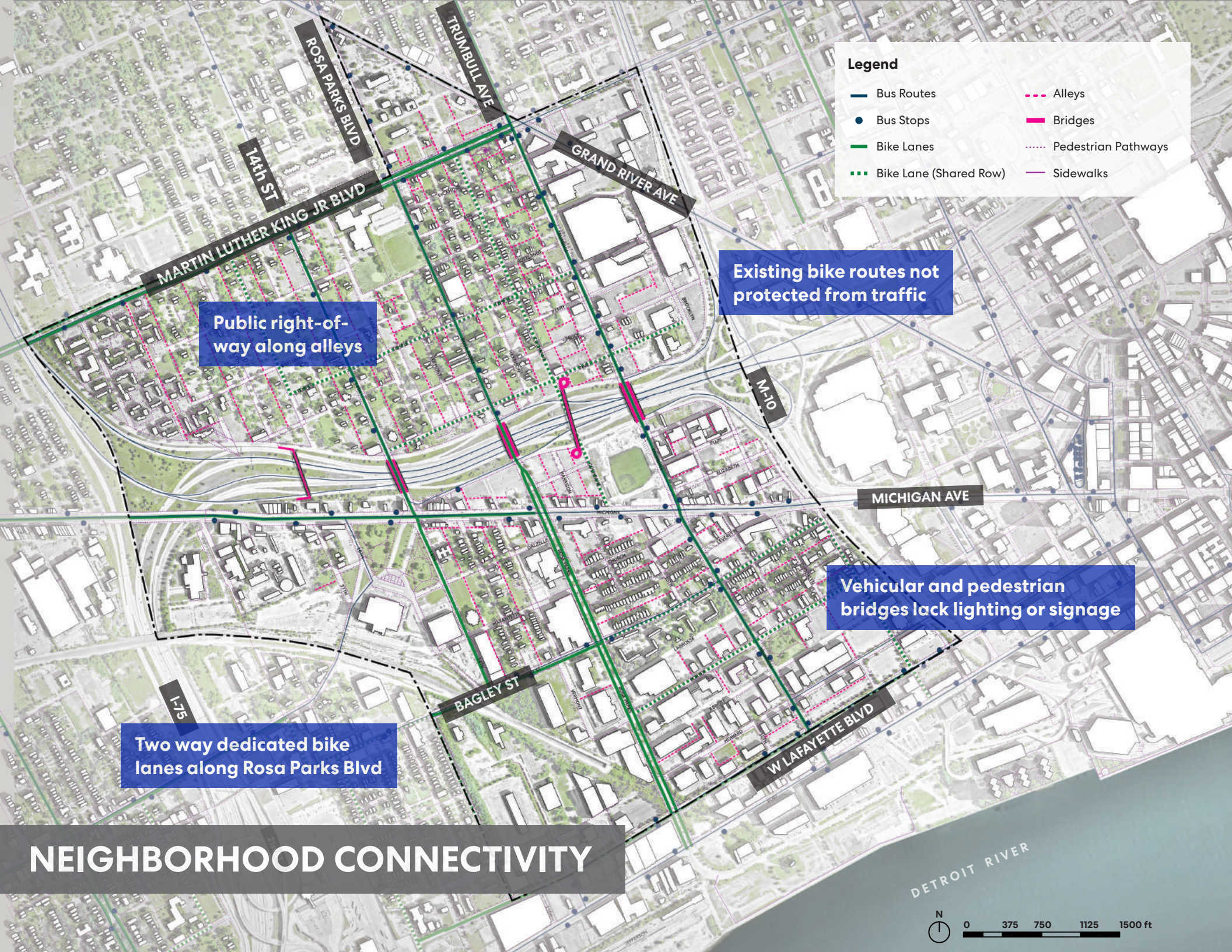

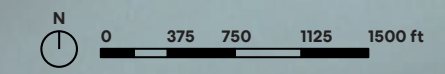
