



GREATER CORKTOWN "OPEN HOUSE" AND "BUILDING" WORKSHOP RECAP

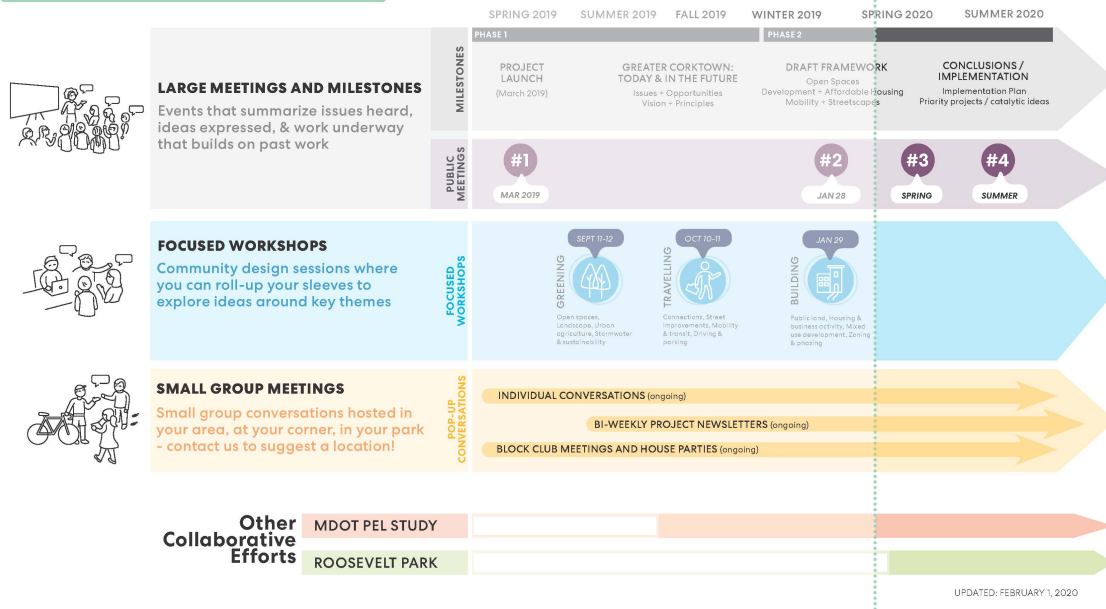
