

**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2009-1**


**TO: ALL BOARDS, COMMISSIONS, DEPARTMENT DIRECTORS, AGENCY HEADS, CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS, AND THE CITY CLERK**

**SUBJECT: CONTINUED TEMPORARY MORATORIUM ON NEW AND PENDING ZONING APPLICATIONS FOR ADULT USES**

**DATE: JANUARY 29, 2009**

Due to the need of City of Detroit elected officials, appointees, and employees to continue their review of the Detroit Zoning Ordinance, Section 61-1-1 *et seq.* of the 1984 Detroit City Code, as well as other provisions of the City Code that relate to adult uses, and for the City of Detroit to enact any necessary amendments to the City Code, the temporary moratorium on new and pending zoning applications for adult uses, which was established by Executive Order No. 2008-1 and extended by Executive Orders Nos. 2008-2, 2008-3, 2008-4 and 2008-5, requires additional time. Therefore, Executive Order No. 2008-1 is extended and, unless extended by further order, shall expire on May 30, 2009.

Pursuant to the powers vested in me by the 1963 Michigan Constitution and by the 1997 Detroit City Charter, I, Kenneth V. Cockrel, Jr., Mayor of the City of Detroit, issue this Executive Order. This Executive Order is effective this date.
