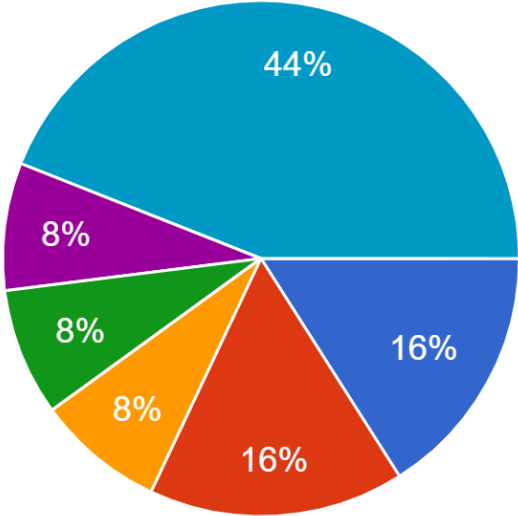

25 responses



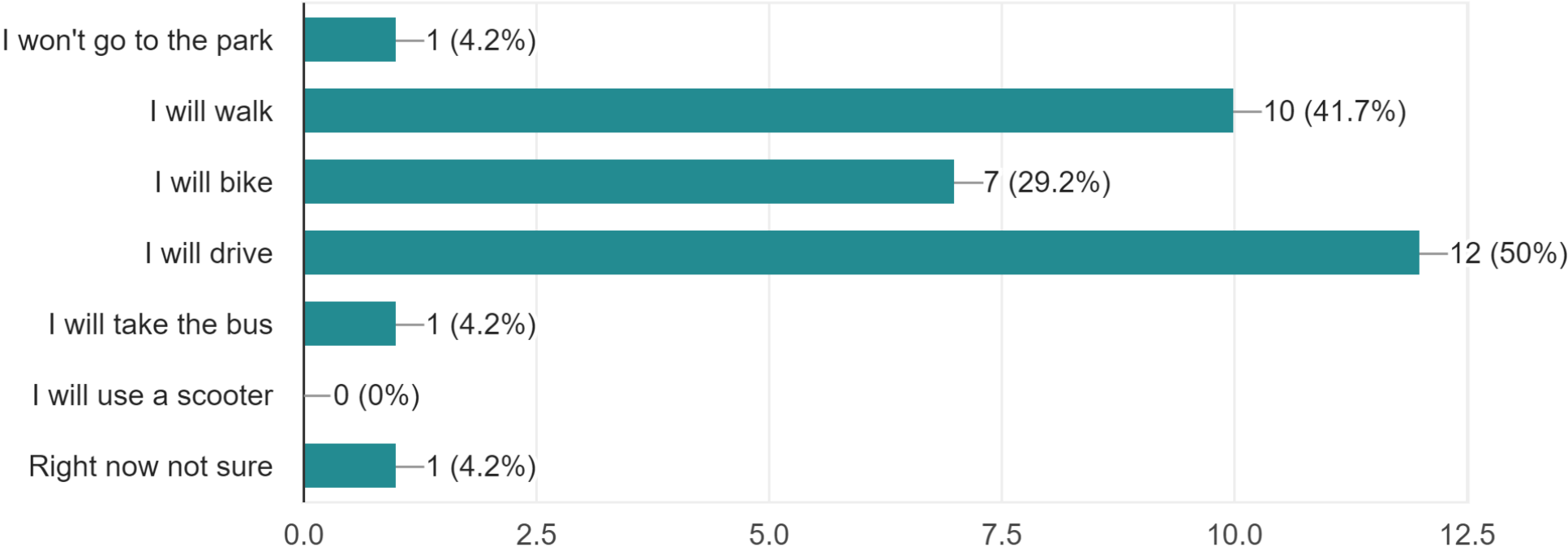
-  less than 1/4 mile (5 minute walk)

How do you plan on getting to Tireman-Minock Park once it is completed ?

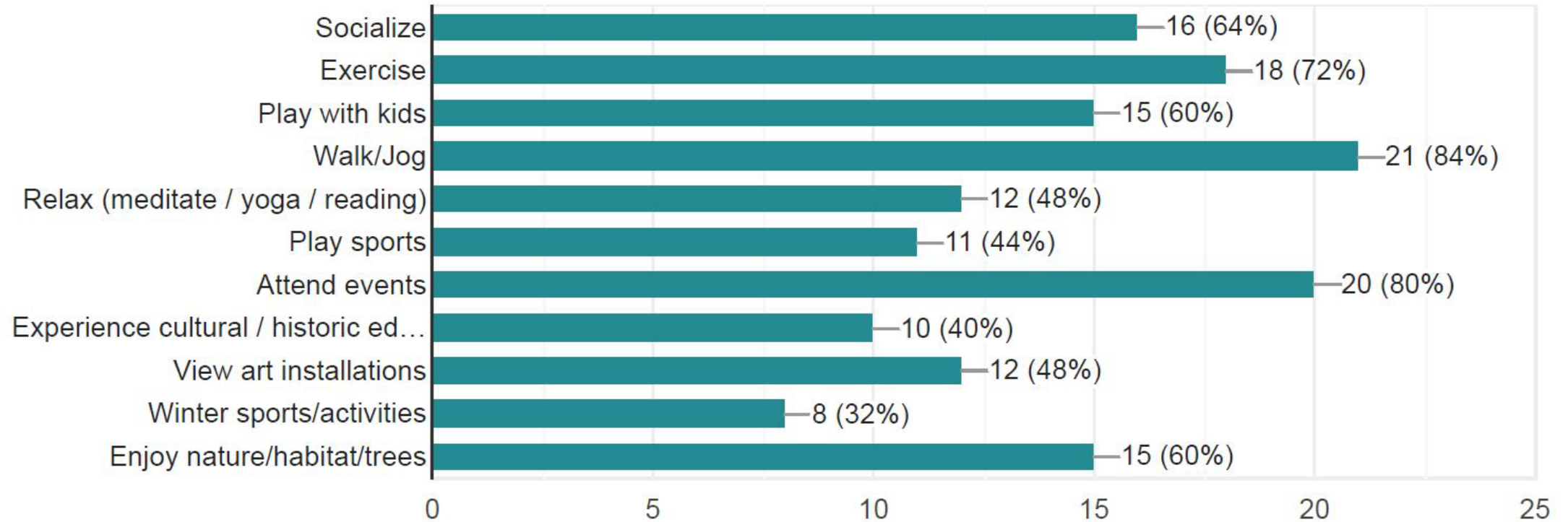

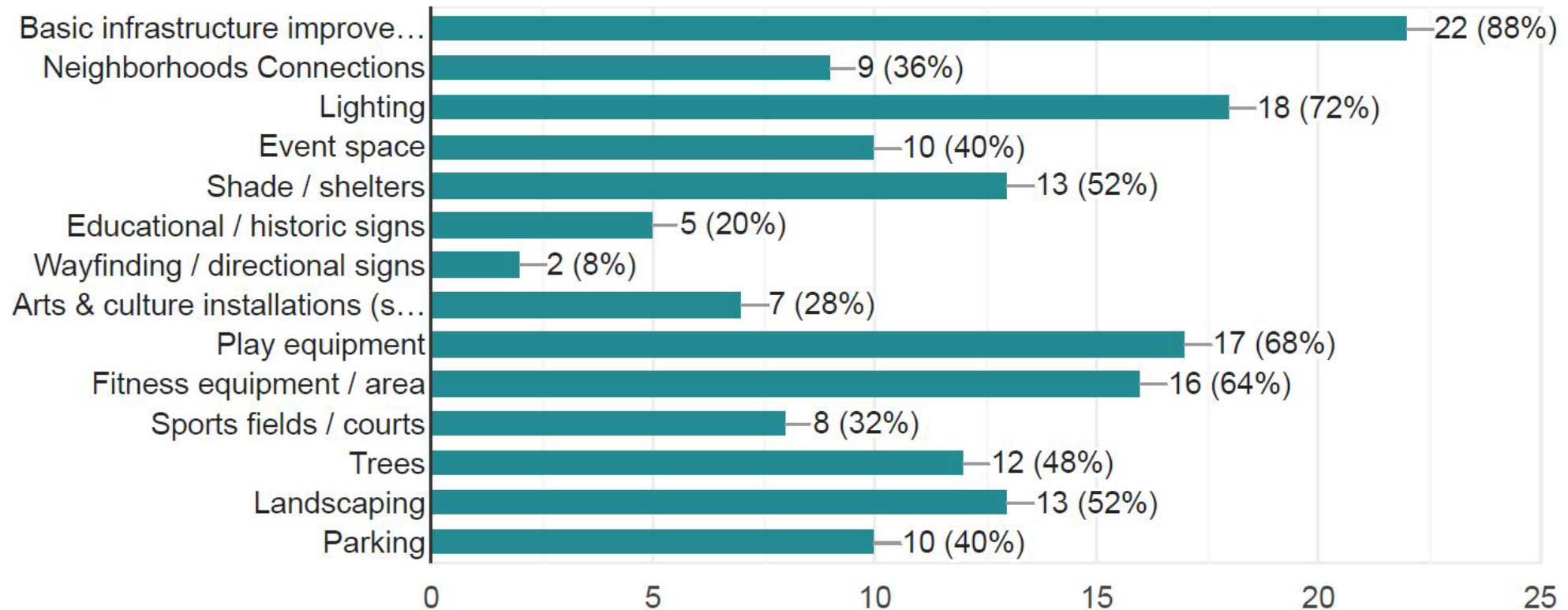
- Have fun
