Notes:

- **Number of Inspectors:** Includes supervisors and both the Food Sanitation and Community Industrial Hygiene cost center
- **Number of fixed food service establishments:** The number of establishments that paid for a license for the license year (May1-April 30). These establishments include all licensed food service establishments except temporary, mobile and special transitory food units
- **Required number of inspections:** Is based on the proportion of total establishments that are high risk (2 inspections per year) and low risk (minimum 1 inspection per year)
- **Correction verification within 30 days:** Is based the percent of the inspections that had 1 or more priority and priority foundation violations cited that were documented as corrected within 30 days
- Routine inspections do not include follow up, complaint, and Food Borne illness inspections
- Correction verification, complaint, and food borne illness percentages are from 2019, which was the Health Department's last State accreditation.
