



Open Judicial Segments

Judicial Segments on your criminal record (ICHAT) must be updated before we can determine your expungement eligibility.

What is an open segment?

An open segment can appear when:

- You were arrested but not charged;
- You were convicted but the conviction was not correctly reported by the court;
- You have an open criminal case;
- You have an active arrest warrant; or
- Your case is non-public but was not correctly sealed.

How do I find my open judicial segment(s)?

Find the row on your ICHAT that has an empty judicial segment. Locate the arresting agency. (See example)

How do I update my open segment(s)?

Detroit Police Department Arrests

If the arresting agency is DPD, we can help! We offer appointments on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays to meet with DPD and have your ICHAT updated. Email PCSwarrants@detroitmi.gov to schedule an appointment. Bring your photo ID.

Wayne County Sheriff Arrests

If the arresting agency is the Wayne County Sheriff, email PCSwarrants@detroitmi.gov for assistance.

Other Arrests

Call or take a printed copy of your ICHAT to the arresting agency and ask to have the open segment updated or removed. If the arresting agency cannot assist, call or take your ICHAT to the court where your case was handled and ask the court to update the Judicial Segment of your ICHAT with the Michigan State Police.

What I do after my open segment(s) is updated?

When all the open segments are updated, email us at PCSwarrants@detroitmi.gov and let us know! We will obtain a new ICHAT and email you with an update.

Please note: if you have an active felony warrant, you may be detained by law enforcement.
