

# CDBG-DR ACTION PLAN AMENDMENT PUBLIC NOTICE

The United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has awarded the City of Detroit an additional \$95 million under the Community Development Block Grant - Disaster Recovery program (CDBG-DR).

This award is specifically for aiding Detroit in long-term recovery from the June 2021 presidentially declared disaster and mitigating the risk and impact of future disasters.

The Detroit Housing and Revitalization Department is looking for YOUR feedback on the city's Substantial Amendment to CDBG-DR Action Plan, which proposes updates to Housing, Infrastructure, and Public Facilities Programs. These updates include:
