




Falling In Love with BLACK History! Did you know:

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Partner Spotlight





Corktown Health and Gleaners provide amazing services, and many of them come directly to YOU!

Corktown Health provided "Walkers and Wheelers" and the "Healthy Heart Ambassador" programs. They brought free testing supplies, first aid, and unique swag to our "3rd Annual Health Fair." Residents that attend the "Made With Love Cooking Class" twice monthly, can participate in Smoking Cessation classes, obtain services tailored for the LGBTQIA+ community, and receive many free or low-cost medical and health services. They also provide transportation for most sessions. Be sure to find the right fit for you!

Gleaners offered on-site nutrition classes and cooking demonstrations for adults, youth, and children. The "Cooking Matters" series offers 6 sessions for participants and they learn how to cook nutritious meals on a budget and support decreasing food insecurity among families, by providing groceries to prepare meals at home. We had 10 CKG families complete the series and 12 families to complete "Cooking Matters At the Store," and they received a \$10 gift card. Gleaners also provides monthly food distribution on the 2nd Monday of each month, providing 25 households with 50lbs of food to ensure no one goes to bed hungry. **All** classes and distributions are **FREE**!
