

She conducted a survey about parking around the Corktown neighborhood. Lisa Prince from Heritage Works also attended the meeting. She shared a Summer Arts Internship for 2025. Relocation Information

Residents in **buildings 8, 9, and 10** should have received a <u>Notice of Eligibility</u> and will be receiving a letter, rescinding the <u>90-Day</u> <u>Notice to Vacate</u> that previously went out from IMS. As a reminder, Left Field is not an available option for relocation.

If you have not received your notices, please reach out to IMS, as soon as possible.

IMS will be scheduling follow up meetings with those residents who received a notice. During these interviews, IMS will address any questions you have about the redevelopment and its potential impact on your household.


