Plan Detroit is our roadmap for future development Recommendations will focus on aligning land use policy with:

- A shared vision for Detroit's future
- Infrastructure, transportation, economic development and other strategic priorities



# **TECHNICAL WORK**

## PRIOR PLAN AUDIT

A review of 35 previously completed City plans.

#### HELPS US ANSWER THESE QUESTIONS:

What are the common planning topics that the Master Plan should cover?

What are some common values that could guide policy?

What are the common or competing policy goals we need to incorporate into the Plan?

## COMMUNITY SNAPSHOT

An analysis of existing conditions and trends across eight planning topics.

#### HELPS US ANSWER THESE QUESTIONS:

How has Detroit changed over the past 10-20 years?

What are the biggest challenges and opportunities that the Master Plan can or should address?

## LAND USE ANALYSIS

A deeper dive into land use patterns and how they relate to policies, planning priorities, and zoning.

#### HELPS US ANSWER THESE QUESTIONS:

How can Detroit align transit investment and development opportunities to support strong neighborhoods and job centers?

Where and how should Detroit strengthen its commercial corridors based on their current performance and future potential?

# VISION & VALUES

A Vision is a forward-looking declaration that outlines our long-term hopes and goals. It is short, clear, and aspirational.

**Values** are the core principles that will guide the City of Detroit's actions and decisions.




