DWSD'S STORMWATER AND WATER MAIN UPGRADE PROJECT

The Detroit Water and Sewerage Department (DWSD) will begin construction on Oakman Boulevard between Joy Road and Tireman Avenue this spring.

In order to reduce neighborhood flooding, DWSD will be re-routing storm pipes, replacing catch basins and installing green stormwater infrastructure practices, including bioretention gardens, in the medians. DWSD will also be replacing the water main and lead service lines (where they exist).

Attend the informational meeting to learn about the project, hear the planned timeline from the contractor, and ask your questions.

Included in this packet is:

1. A project fact sheet, with detailed information
2. An agreement form on the DWSD Lead Service Line Replacement Program (if you already submitted a signed agreement, there is no need to send it again.)

This comprehensive water and sewer project is the first of its kind in Detroit. We look forward to our continued partnership with the community to upgrade the water system and improve stormwater management.
