We are over 30 year residents of Indian Village. Several years ago our block of Burns off of Jefferson, received cement replacement curbs without our approval or notification. They claimed the curbs needed replacement due to over 50% being damaged, which wasn't true. Our neighbor at the time was so incensed that he stood in front of the machine to block the workers. The company boss, a firm from Macomb Co. was rude and bullied us and our neighbors. They even demolished our carriage walk leading to the street, which was in perfect shape. They put a cement carriage walk in front of our house that was so white I thought it had snowed every time I looked out the window.

The company dumped the surplus cement in the alley sewer and we had lots residual problems. It took some time for the City to remedy this.

With a lot of expense, a group of neighbors hired the Finnegan Cement Co. to replace our carriage walk and broken flags in front of our house with appropriate aggregate material.

We didn't trust the City to follow the historic guidelines. Kind of like if they blacktopped Historic Canfield.

As our neighbor Mark Reynolds pointed out you cannot trust DTE to do the right thing.

Please consider our concerns.
