

In answer to your request, we propose to furnish all labor, materials, equipment, supervision and insurance to complete the following work on the above captioned project.

Below is our proposed scope of work:

- Mobilize to the jobsite and dispatch all necessary equipment, material and personnel.
- Set-up site protection and barricade off the work area for a safe working environment.
- Carefully demolish front steps and landing. All debris will be hauled away from site.
- Retaining walls/capstones are to remain (they will be repaired in place).
- Furnish and install a new sand base and compact subgrade.
- Form up the steps and landing with all necessary reinforcing steel.
- Pour and place new concrete for the steps and landing.
- Remove formwork from steps and landing.
- Tuckpoint open mortar joints located within the retaining walls and fill in open voids with new brick units matching the existing as close as possible.
- All of the gray coating located on the side of the retaining walls, steps and front facing brick will be removed to expose the original brick.
- Install new surface mounted railing through the middle of the steps with three (3) connection points.
- Install urethane cove sealant to both sides of the steps, where the landing meets concrete and also at the capstones on the retaining walls.
- Clean up the work area, call off all equipment and demobilize from the jobsite.
