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## 1364-1368 Labrosse

## **Existing Conditions:**

The existing lots, 1364-1368, Labrosse are currently vacant. The site is slightly overgrown with unplanned vegetation.

During the late 19th and early 20th century there used to be a building facing along the 8th Street façade. This contained a hardware store with residences above.

## **Project Description:**

Erect (5) ground-up new construction townhomes on the existing vacant lot. The intent is to replace the mass along 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue which was lost during the great ravaging of Detroit during the mid-20<sup>th</sup> century to create parking lots.

## Proposed Work:

- 1. Install a new concrete/masonry "half basement"
- 2. Wood stud exterior walls with
  - a. Street facing walls, face brick masonry, color TBD
  - b. Non-street walls, cementitious fiber siding, Hardie Board, color TBD
- 3. Front entrance off 8th Street
  - a. Concrete steps and stoop
  - b. Vertical wood siding around entrance door to roof
  - c. Wood door
- 4. Rear of townhouse
  - a. Install a new deck with handrails at the rear of the house as shown on Sheet A5.10.
  - b. Wood and glass entrance door
  - c. Entrance to garden level half basement
- 5. 3rd Floor of townhouse facing 8th Street
  - a. Metal panel system, final color TBD
  - b. Wood and glass door to outdoor roof deck
- 6. Windows Andersen 200 series wood window, white interior, exterior color TBD from standard colors available
- 7. Roof TPO membrane roof, white color on poly-iso insulation
- 8. Concrete parking spaces off the alley
